

RESOLUTION #2015-136

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HEALTH COMMISSIONER AND HIS/HER DESIGNEE TO INITIATE ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS LEADING TO RETAIL FOOD ESTABLISHMENT OR FOOD SERVICE OPERATION LICENSE SUSPENSION OR REVOCATION IN NON-EMERGENCY SITUATIONS

WHEREAS, Revised Code Sections 3717.29 and 3717.49 state the licensor may suspend or revoke a retail food establishment and food service operation license on determining that the license holder is in violation of any requirement of Chapter 3717 or rules adopted under it applicable to retail food establishments and food service operations, including a violation evidenced by documented failure to maintain sanitary conditions within the establishment or operation; and

WHEREAS, the licensor under Revised Code Section 3717.01 means a board of health approved under Section 3717.11;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Galion City Board of Health hereby authorizes the health commissioner and his/her designee to initiate enforcement actions leading to license suspension or revocation as specified in Revised Code Sections 3717.29 and 3717.49 and Administrative Code Section 901:3-4-08, on determining that a license holder is in violation of any requirement of Chapter 3717 or rules adopted under it applicable to retail food establishments and food service operations.
