Environmental Health

Food Safety –

Eighteen-O-Three Taproom was given final approval on 07/10/15 to begin operation. Galion Posey D's, located at 640 East Church Street, closed permanently under the existing licensee on 06/28/15. Posey D's, as it will now be known, has undergone pre-licensing inspections under licensee Patricia Bemiller who previously operated the facility. It is expected to be back in business during August. Seasonal food facility inspections are wrapping up.

Public Health Nuisances –

Fourteen new public health nuisance cases were reported in July, all of which are based on solid waste complaints.

Crawford County Municipal Court activity summary:

311 Third Avenue –

Review hearing on 07/14/15, \$400/\$500 fine imposed for ongoing violations & case #CRB 1501454 closed

Defendant cited again, abated nuisance as of 07/28/15

436 Hensley Avenue –

Review hearing on 07/14/15, defendant failed to appear; fine imposed for ongoing violations & case #CRB 1501458 closed

Defendant cited again, will be referred for prosecution for a 2nd offense if clean-up not complete by 08/21/15

516 Second Avenue –

Case referred for prosecution on 07/31/15; hearing set for 08/11/15
