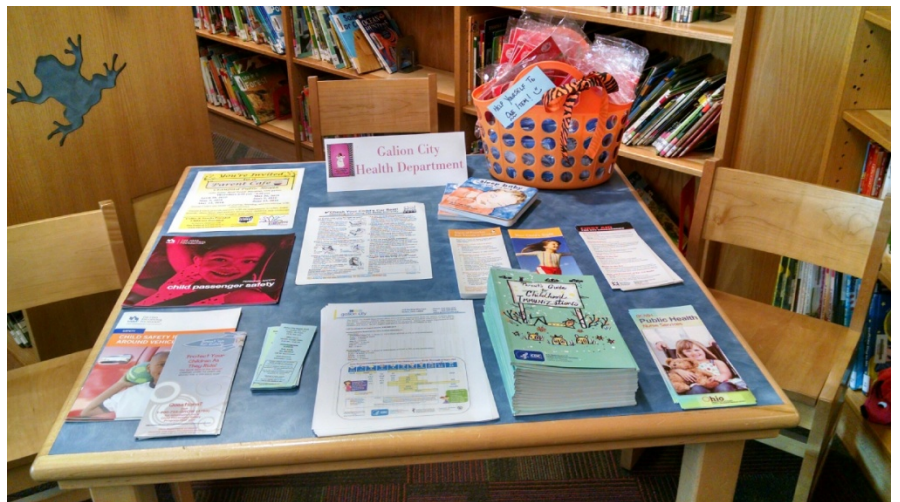


## Galion City Health Dept. Nursing Report for April 2016

- **BCMh**- Our total caseload is 44 patients in the combined diagnostic & treatment programs. Theresa reports we have had 3 patients leave our area, but we have had 3 patients move into our district. She had made several home visits.
- **Car Seats**-Theresa did 3 car seat education sessions this month. She also attended the regional meeting for the program in Bowling Green, Ohio.
- **Immunizations**-Staff continue to learn to use Medisoft for clinic documenting & scheduling. All will have some further training this summer. Nurses have been doing the inventory on the first Monday of the month. Nurses have been doing the "You Call the Shots" education modules as assigned to keep up to date and earn ceu credit. We have scheduled 2 adolescent immunization clinics for the Galion City Schools early release days in May and have been getting that publicized.
- **Schools**-Kindergarten screenings at Galion City were completed. No updates on any school contracts for next year at this time, but all 3 schools have been contacted and contracts emailed/sent out. We continue to have RN/BSN students from Ashland University on Tuesdays for their clinical experiences and will throughout the summer. I attended the ODH Regional School Nurse conference in Akron, Ohio and will be discussing updates at the May Nursing staff meeting.





- **Communicable Disease-** Case counts for the month of April 2016 will be available at the Board of Health meeting.
- **Outreach-**
  - **Galion Preschoolers-** Nurse Kara visited with the Preschoolers at the Galion Primary School. She shared a story, talked about bugs, germs, and even brought some Minion and Super Hero band-aids.
