


About the Program


The Galion City Health Department's Vital Statistics Department issues birth certificates, death certificates, and burial permits. For birth records, it can issue certified copies for anyone born in the state of Ohio from December 20, 1908 to the present. For death records we can issue certified copies for deaths that occurred within the city limits of Galion from December 20, 1908 to the present.


The Vital Statistics Department is responsible for registering births, deaths, and fetal deaths that occur within the Galion city limits. The department creates and registers all home births that occur within the city limits as well. The Vital Statistics Department assists customers with completing Acknowledgements of Paternity to add a father to a record and completing Birth Affidavits to make minor corrections on birth records. It also issues copies of records to the Veteran's Administration, assists customers with genealogical requests, and collects data regarding birth and death events within the city for statistical use.




