# of Community Members Impacted: 25-30 members from the public stopped at the table either to spin the wheel for Healthy Homes & Lead Poisoning Prevention information/lead dust clean-up buckets and mosquito/tick control information and mosquito dunks, screen repair kits and/or mosquito repellent wipes.

**Outcomes of event:** It was successful as we were able to reach more of the community and focus on specific programmatic goals that we don't during normal business hours. The games and candy/water for prizes seem to attract more people in general. The mosquito dunks and supplies continue to be popular. Approximately 11 cleaning buckets with lead specific cleaning instruction were given out to eligible individuals/families.

**In what ways can outreach be improved?** GCHD may want to advertise prior to the event that they will be participating, along with the available activities. The last 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday event tends to have lower attendance due to the conflict with the Bratwurst Festival in Bucyrus as well.
