

Galion City Board of Health **Nursing Division Monthly Report for June 2021**

COVID-19 Contact tracing

- A total of 10 new cases of COVID-19 occurred during the month of June.
- 1 case was hospitalized, no reported deaths.
- 1 outbreak at a LTCF is being investigated. No new cases have been reported since 6/25/2021.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- Total COVID Vaccines administered during the month of May: 45 (Last month 134)
- Total COVID vaccines administered: 3,656 (7/6/2021)
- During the month of June, vaccination clinics were held at Wyandot Square Apartments, Moccasin Run Apartments and East Apartments.
- Cards have been distributed to Police and Fire for homebound residents to receive a vaccine in their home. A home visit was conducted during the month of June.
- Please see the letter from ODH on the vaccination administration Fees. Emily Miller is requesting that the fees for the COVID vaccine administration be discussed.

CMH

- Lynn Corwin is now in orientation for the CMH program.
- Billing for the year was completed on July 2nd for \$1030
- A home visit was completed on Thursday July 1st.
- A Northwest regional PHN update meeting is scheduled on 7/23, this will be held virtually.

Car Seats

- One car seat class was held during the month of June. One seat was distributed.
- Reports for Quarter 3 (April to June) was submitted to Ohio Buckle Buckeyes (OBB). Five seats were distributed during the 3rd quarter.

Immunizations

- A total of 40 regular appointments were scheduled with 1 no show for the month of June. A total of 63 non-COVID vaccines were administered.
- Last June, a total of 43 appointments were scheduled with 3 no shows. A total of 51 vaccines were administered.
