


# Galion City Board of Health Environmental Division Monthly Report for July 2021

## **Food Safety**

I have inspected and licensed some Mobile FSO's during July, and one temporary at the Galion Pickle Run on July 2<sup>nd</sup>. The state allowed for food licenses to have an extension for license renewal until July 1, 2021. Unfortunately, Tim Horton's, Domino's, and Valero Galion 24 Store, all 3, were assessed late fees for not renewing by the extended deadline. Although I have not received a call from the interested party, I have heard that a Mexican restaurant is looking into purchasing the site beside the bowling alley.

#### **Public Health Nuisances**

There were 11 nuisance complaints during the month of July. One was about Covid-19, one was landlord/tenant issue, one was lead poisoning (EPA RRP) violation, five were pest/vermin/animal issues, and four were solid waste complaints. Several complaints are being investigated in conjunction with the zoning inspector. Most of the complaints are now closed or referred.



# General Environmental Health


The invoice was completed for the manufactured home park inspections, and we should receive the \$500 payment by mid September.

Healthy Homes and lead poisoning prevention activities were completed, and the invoice for purchases for cleaning supplies plus some of my time spent was submitted to ODH for reimbursement.

The Ohio Department of Health asked us to do the Smoke Free investigations contract again from 7/1/21 to 6/30/23 which reimburses us \$125 per completed complaint investigation made against a business in the city of Galion.

### **Rabies Prevention**

GCHD received 2 cat bite reports in the month of July. Both were stray/feral cats. One of the strays were caught, euthanized and tested by ODH. The cat was negative for rabies.
