 conditions, live or work in a high-risk setting
Moderna 3rd dose available for immunocompromised individuals

COVID-19 Contact tracing

- A total of 223 new cases of COVID-19 were reported during the month of October.
- 1 reported hospitalization
- 1 reported death

COVID Outbreak Investigations

- No new outbreaks were opened during the month of October.
- Two LTCF continue to be investigated for ongoing outbreaks

COVID-19 Vaccine

- Total COVID Vaccines administered during the month of October: 59
- Total COVID vaccines administered: 4014
- COVID vaccine is continuing to be offered to homebound individuals as well as in LTCF as needed.
- Vaccines continue to be administered at no cost.

Immunizations

- A total of 132 non-COVID vaccines were administered.

- Three TST were administered.
