COVID-19 Contact tracing

• A total of 16 new cases of COVID-19 were reported during the month of March.

COVID Outbreak Investigations

- All Hospital associated outbreaks were closed during the month of March.
- The Outbreak associated with Covert Manufacturing is on it's third week without new cases and will close on 4/7 if no new cases are reported.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- Total COVID Vaccines administered during the month of March: 28
- Total COVID vaccines administered: 4,462
- Total patients immunized with COVID vaccine March 2022: 28
- COVID vaccine is continuing to be offered to homebound individuals as well as in LTCF as needed.
- COVID-19 Vaccines continue to be administered at no cost.
- A Public clinic was held on March 14th at the Grace Point Church. \$100 Gift Cards were advertised and distributed to persons receiving their first dose.
- An employee clinic was held on March 14th for Flick Packaging. This included family wishing to receive the COVID vaccine.
