

STI & HIV PREVENTION DEFINED

Surveillance

- STIs are reportable to local health departments.
- This assures that individuals are treated and resources are directed to areas with the highest need.

Screening & Treatment

- Testing and treatment for STIs.
(including chlamydia, gonorrhea, HIV and syphilis)

Interviewing & Case Finding

- Disease Intervention Specialists (DIS) provide health information to individuals regarding their HIV and syphilis infections and assist their contacts with referral to testing and treatment.
- This further reduces transmission of infection.

Prevention & Education

- Educational materials, condom distribution, treatment guidelines, technical assistance, & more!
