Disability & Chronic Pain

No programs currently exist to address Arthritis/Rheumatism.

Goals:

- Avita Health System to explore opportunity to recruit Rheumatologist.
- Implement "A Matter of Balance" program by December 2013.

Mental Health & Mental Disorders

Community Counseling does screening and educates on the signs of suicide tendencies. Currently there is one full time psychiatrist and one nurse practitioner who see 4500 patients annually. Crawford County Jobs & Family Services has several part time psychiatrists.

Goals:

- Avita Health System to explore opportunity to recruit a mental health provider.
- SOS Signs of Suicide a program to educate children in the schools. Todd Martin will introduce Jody Demo-Hodges at the August School Superintendents' meeting where she will discuss the program.

Another meeting will be held July 12 from noon to 1:30 pm to finish goals for the needs listed below:

Substance Abuse

- Dr. Novack will obtain more information on Vivitrol.
- Marion Crawford Prevention has a leadership program at the school level to educate students on the dangers of drug use, to combat myths, teach facts, and give positive choices. An Opiate Task Force works more with parents to educate them as well.
- All 6 schools are cooperating in a survey on safety (drugs, wearing bicycle helmets, etc.), and to get data on what the kids are doing.

Tobacco Use

- The Crawford County Health Department addresses second hand smoke in public buildings.
- Four times each year law enforcement personnel target underage sales (\$1,000 fine).

Heart Disease/Stroke

• Health Department wants to find ways to identify high blood pressure outcomes.

Nutrition & Overweight

- Farmer's Market, Food Lover's Club
- Suggest "What's for Supper?", or "Mother's Club" to help educate families on good nutrition.
